Cash money: 1st 1.000,00 EUR, 2nd 500,00 EUR, 3rd 300,00 EUR, 4th 200,00 EUR

Cash money pay out regardless of division and nationality. **Ranking based on added times for Pole Bending and Barrel Race at the final run's added.**

Pay out entry fee: 40 % of entry fee paid out according to NBHA o.G. rule book after final result separately for PB and BR. Actual membership with the NBHA o.G. required.

Clos of entry: Saturday, 15 October 2011

Friday, November 18, 2011 - 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. approx.

First GO with 2 runs to qualify for 2nd GO (1 scratch run and 5 sec. rule). 100 % of the rider/horse combinations will be qualified for 2nd GO, based on added times for Pole Bending and Barrel Race.

Saturday, November 19, 2011 – 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. approx.

Second GO with 2 runs to qualify for final (1 scratch run and 5 sec. rule). Times of Pole Bending and Barrel Race from 1st and 2nd GO will be added. The first 20 rider/horse combinations based on added times from 1st and 2nd GO will be allowed to enter the final.

Sunday, November 20, 2011 – 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. approx.

FINAL Pole Bending & Barrel Race with 2 runs each (RUN's will be ADDED, 5 sec. rule)

Required Memberships

Riders with German residence: Valid membership 2011 of NBHA of Germany required

Foreign riders: Valid membership 2011 of each national NBHA required

Rules for German Championship

Only riders with German residence will be able to gain German Championship. German Champion will be the first German rider in the final ranking. Reserve Champion will be the second German rider in the final ranking.

Foreign riders rules

TRACES-carnet required. Please regard each country's national laws.

Rules for all riders

The competition has the categories: OPEN category in the divisions D1-D4 / SENIOR / JUNIOR / YOUTH / KIDDY. If in a category are less than 3 nominations the category can be canceled. Class in Class is possible. Number of rider/horse combination is limited to 50, listed in the order of the date of the inscription received by the showmanagement's office.

On time vaccins (see health conditions). Equine passport and vaccination passport as well have to be presented to the showmanagement. Horses with no equine passport and/or inadequate vaccination will be not allowed to start. For each horse an actual liability insurance is mandatory. Validity of the liability insurance has to be proved by a copy of the insurance policy added to the inscription sheet.

Participation at the competition is on each riders and/ or Horse owners own risk. Under no circumstances the organizer will responsible and/or liable for any damages caused by the riders, by their grooms or by their horses to its own, to any other persons, to any other horses, to any objects and/or to any installations.

For animal-protection-legal reasons it is strictly forbidden, to leave horses on horse trailers or horse trucks over night. Building of paddocks is also not allowed at any time.

Horses boxes

Horses boxes are for rental in the stable tent. The stable tent is located directly in front of the fair hall in the open area of the fairground.

Health conditions

TRACES-carnet for horses from outside Germany required. Inoculation against influenza viruses disease and actual repetition inoculation is mandatory accordingly actual rules of German. Implementation instructionsto the compulsory vaccination siehe below.

The show will be supervised by the official veterinarian departement of the City of Saarbruecken, whose actual regulations and directions at the date of show are a matter of concern.

PLEASE NOTE: National associations must imperatively inform their members.

Implementation instructions to the compulsory vaccination in accordance with LPO of the German FN

1. The current implementation instructions are valid in accordance with § 66 LPO of the German FN.
2. Horses, those are not inoculated against influenza viruses or those inoculation is incorrect documented in their equine passport (see in addition # 3), are not accepted and/or will be disqualified from the competition. Horses concerned are to be removed immediately from the show ground.
3. Inoculation against influenza viruses infection must be given by a veterinary surgeon and must be documented by this in the equine passport accordingly as follows
 - A) The basic immunization consists of three inoculations. The first two inoculations must be given within of 42 days at least up to 70 days at most. Deviating data of vaccine manufacturers must be considered, as far as they are under the before mentioned time intervals. The third inoculation must be given within 6 months (+/- 21 days) after the second inoculation.
 - B) Repetition inoculation must be given within 6 months (+/- 21 days).
4. Additionally an inoculation against herpes viruses disease is urgently recommended.
5. Inoculation against tetanus disease is judged as natural.
6. A participation in the competition is possible if:
 - a) the first two inoculations for basic immunization are given and after the second inoculation of the basic immunization 14 days are passed.
 - b) for the repetition inoculation 7 days after the last inoculation are passed and the repetition inoculation has been given not later than 7 months + 21 days before.
7. Control of this instructions against influenza viruses infections will be done from veterinary surgeon of the competition. This control can done before entering of the showground or at any time during the competition.
